## **'It's scandalous' says Ed Davey MP**

**Half a million retirees eligible for a UK state pension and who now live abroad have their payments frozen at the level due when they first claimed it after leaving the UK.**

This means that retirees living in more than 100 countries including Australia, Canada and South Africa receive as little as £20 per week when the full state pension is about to rise to £230 in 2025.



### **Says Lib Dem Leader Sir Ed Davey MP**

"It's scandalous that when people leave the UK their state pensions are frozen. Liberal Democrats are deeply sympathetic to the plight of the thousands of pensioners worldwide who have been left without their proper state pension due to these antiquated rules.

This has been a political football for far too long. The Government must do far more to put reciprocal agreements in place, to ensure that pensioners who have lived and worked in Britain receive what they are fairly owed."
